## Directions

It is always recommended that you do a soil analysis to ensure the proper rate of application.

### Plant Food Recommendation

Sprinkle 3 tablespoons per 100 square feet (1 teaspoon per plant) around the root zone. If possible, mix it in with your fertilizer and work it into the soil.

### Soil Acidifier Recommendation

In the absence of a soil test, follow the rates below. Results can take up to several weeks depending on rate, soil temperature, and timing of application. Reduce the rates by one-third for sandy soils and increase by one-half for clay soils. In general, the optimum range for blue hydrangeas is 5.5 – 6.0, and for blueberries it is 4.5 – 5.0.

### Rates per plant to turn Hydrangeas Blue:

- For established plants use 1/2 cup per plant.
- For new plants use 1/4 cup per plant.

Sprinkle the recommended amount evenly under the plant and water well.
